Inspired by her parents' work ethic and her grandparents' love of all natural things, Seda knew from the start that she was destined to create organic products essential to wellness. Growing up, Seda split her time between New York and New Jersey, with summers spent on her grandparents' farm in Turkey. As such, her life continues to be a fine balancing act of old meets new. Ahu Yıldırmaz is the President and Chief Executive Officer of the Coleridge Initiative, a non-profit organization, whose goal is to use data to transform the way governments access and use data for the social good through training programs, research projects and a secure data facility. The secure facility was initially built at the behest of the Census Bureau to inform the decision-making of the Commission on Evidence Based Policy.

Previously, as the founder and former Head of the ADP Research Institute, Dr. Yıldırmaz created a legacy framework of unique data analyses and insights leveraging company's administrative payroll data, which included developing the ADP National Employment Report, Workforce Vitality Report and Evolution of Work research series. She is frequently cited by leading business publications, including The New York Times, The Wall Street Journal, USA Today, Reuters, CNBC, CNN, and Forbes. Throughout her career, Dr. Yıldırmaz's interest in research and data has been guided in their application for public good. Her experience includes several roles with progressing responsibilities at ADP, Johnson & Johnson, and AT&T in the areas of research, strategy, corporate finance, and market insights. She has taught courses in economics and finance at New York University, Manhattan College, and the City University of New York. Dr. Yıldırmaz earned a doctorate degree in Economics from the Graduate Center of the City University of New York and a bachelor's degree in economics from Boğaziçi University in Istanbul, Türkiye.

Hande Turan Page was born in Istanbul, Turkey, in 1977. She earned her bachelor's degree in economics from Uludağ University, followed by a second degree in Mathematics from Queens College of New York. She completed her master's degree in mathematics education at City College of New York. She published her first book, titled "A Few Strange Stories," in both English and Turkish, which was distributed in Turkey and the USA. Additionally, she wrote a play called "Marriage Project," scheduled to premiere in May in NYC. She resides in New Jersey with her husband and two sons. She currently works as a mathematics teacher in the NYC Department of Education.



Dr.FUNDA SÜER-Executive VP Clinical Diagnostic and CLIA Laboratory director

Associate Professor Dr. Funda Suer currently Executive Vice President of Clinical Diagnostics, and Clinical Laboratory Director at Quadrant Biosciences, Quadrant Laboratories, where she focuses on neurological disorders genetics, such as Autism, intellectual disability. Prior to joining Quadrant Dr Suer worked at Mount Sinai Hospital, Icahn Sch of Medicine, where she served most recently as Senior Director of Clinical Laboratory and Head of Diagnostic Testing at Department of Genetics. Associate Professor Dr. Suer has extensive experience with clinical molecular genetics and genomics, she presented, published in national and international journals, meetings, invited lectures, training. She developed numerous clinical biotechnologies launched as clinical genetic tests in the last 20 years. She has overseen commercial and academic laboratories as Senior Clinical Laboratory Director and corporate brand transformations, including Quest Diagnostics, Athena Diagnostics, Sema4, Georgetown University, Children's Hospital to name a few.

Dr. Suer graduate of Ankara University has master's in molecular biology, received her PhD in medical genetics at Gulhane Military Medical Academy in Turkey, and completed her postdoctoral medical residency/fellowship training program in clinical molecular genetics at the National Institute of Health Genomic Research Institute (NIH-NHGRI) at Maryland, USA. Additionally, she is a diplomate of the American Board of Medical Genetics and Genomics (ABMGG), a fellow of the American College of Medical Genetics and Genomics (ACMG), is certified by the NYS DOH as a clinical director in molecular genetic testing and a member of the American College of Medical Genetics. Dr. Suer previously established genetics training programs through Harvard University at Quest Diagnostics, and served as a program director, as well as Associate Professor at Mount Sinai Icahn School of Medicine for the ABMGG Laboratory Genetics Training Program. Funda also holds an Associate Professorship degree from Turkish Institute of Higher Education in Medical Genetics.

Clinical Professor of Medicine, NYU Grossman School of Medicine

Dr. Gül Bahtiyar is an accomplished medical doctor and education advocate and comes from a family who attributed great importance to education. She was born in Erzurum and graduated from Istanbul University, Cerrahpasa Medical School and later completed her internal medicine training in the US. Currently she holds the position of Clinical Professor of Medicine at NYU Grossman School of Medicine, and serve as the Division Chief of Endocrinology, Diabetes and Metabolism, NYC Health+Hospitals / Woodhull and Site Program Director for Woodhull, SUNY Downstate Medical Center Endocrine Fellowship Program. In addition to her professional accomplishments, Dr. Bahtiyar is a dedicated philanthropist and an advocate for egalitarian education in Türkiye. She joined Bridge to Türkiye Fund, established NY/NJ Circle in 2014 and became a board member. She obtained consultative status with the UN for the organization in 2016. She hosted numerous meetings with NGO Commission Status of Women (CSW) at the Church Center of the UN in NYC. She is currently the chairperson of Donor Relation and Fundraising Committee of BTF. She tirelessly volunteered for earthquake relief efforts, brought many people and organizations from different backgrounds together to volunteer and generate funding. She continues contribute to Child Amputees of Türkiye Earthquake (CATE Project). She believes that education is a human right and will continue her efforts to support underprivileged children's education in Türkiye as a BTF volunteer.
